Refurbishment with an Extension Project

On Sunday night the 29th of June 2014 the Church Business Meeting voted with an overwhelming majority in favour of full Refurbishment with an Extension.

The outcome of this vote has the following immediate implications:

- 1. The contractors were instructed on the 30th of June to proceed and since then they have come on sight.
- 2. Starting Monday the 7th of July the deaconesses vestry will be demolished in order to comply with the planning permission.
- 3. We will have our last worship service in the sanctuary next week the 12th of July and our first worship service as a main service will take place in the Marquee on the 19th of July. The Marquee will be situated on the grounds of the BUC.
- 4. Staring on Monday the 7th of July the one-way traffic system will come to an end for the duration of the building works. A new two-way system will come into affect. This two-way system will run past the Cedar/Sycamore.
- 5. On Sabbaths parking for disabled badge holders will be available on the BUC grounds and during the week at the back of the Church.
- 6. The Church Board will provide an updated News Letter next week with more information on the above and other matters.

Please continue to keep this project in your prayers and again we ask that if you would like to give financially or of your time to help with this project that you will speak to the Pastoral Team or one of the elders.
