GUCHA ORPHANAGE APPEAL NEXT SABBATH, 13TH FEBRUARY

Jesus rightly predicted, "The poor will always be with us." We have been asked to donate to many worthy causes recently, but the 95 children at Gucha who have lost both parents to the scourge of AIDS are totally dependent on our faithful giving.

Through your generosity over the past year these children have been fed, clothed and educated, which is their only hope up out of the cycle of poverty and destitution. Every month we send £600 directly to them to help with their basic food and clothing. That is £7,200 for the year. Praise God we have never missed a month yet.

Secondary schooling is not state funded in Kenya and 5 additional children are now of secondary school age (last year we funded 13 children through boarding school). The distance of the nearest Adventist secondary school means that these 18 children need to board. By faith we have enrolled all 18 orphans into an Adventist boarding school. Their collective school fees for the first term came to £1,800 which has virtually wiped out our Gucha Orphanage Charity Account Fund with Barclays Bank.

However I am confident that with your continued support we can raise the sum God knows we need to keep the orphanage running and to educate these precious children to prepare them for this life and for eternity. Please plan to give generously next Sabbath morning. Thank you!
